
- > About 2000 films are produced per year worldwide
- > ...**300** of which are distributed worldwide in cinemas
- > ...almost all of these come from the US and the UK
- > ...and generate over **80** % of the **worldwide box office**



> PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION

Of these 300 Films ...

- approx. 50% are from US Major Studios
 ... with own production companies
 ... with own local distribution offices
 >> increasing focus on the US market
- approx. 50% are from Independent producers
 ... without own distribution channels
 >> distribution through worldwide distribution companies



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>> the number of joint projects is increasing

(Joint Projects are films, which are exploited in the US by Major Studios and in the rest of the world by independent distribution companies.)



> MARKET OUTLOOK

The demand for high quality feature films is increasing




> TURNOVER

>> A high proportion of the turnover in 2000 and 2001 is already secured through contracts







annual net profit before effect from merger






